

How to reach the Physics Department from the city center

The map below shows the neighbourhood of the Physics Department



1. Bus stop
2. Small Gate
3. Physics Department

The arrow indicates that there is a walkway between 2 and 3. Google maps does not show that walkway, but be confident that it is there

- Take bus 45 or 18 (at Brignole railway station for example) or bus 44 (in Piazza Dante or Via XX Settembre) and exit in via San Martino – via Papigliano (1 in the map of the previous page)
- Go right (downhill) for 30 meters and take Via Papigliano on the left, which goes uphill (unfortunately...)
- When Via Papigliano ends, go right for ~15 meters in via Giovanni Semeria. You will see a small gate on the left side of the street (2 in the map). Enter it, to take the walkway indicated by the arrow on the map.
- Go ahead on the walkway until you finish it with descending stairs. You will see a really strange building with three entrance doors. From left to right, they are the entrance to Maths, Phys and Chem departments. Go to the Phys Dept and follow the indications at the entrance
- Consider an interval of ~30 minutes (depending on traffic) between the time when you take the bus at the city center and the time when you arrive at the Phys Dept (15-20 minutes of bus and 5-10 minutes of walk).
